

## Text of email from Playdale.

A few weeks ago I met Mr Hicks on site and he explained that the play area could not be installed in its original siting as the area may become used as a car park area if the Duchy of Cornwall estate were to have a couple of houses built on the adjacent (left) side of the vehicle entrance.

With regards to your second question, I have seen no evidence that drainage is a problem on any part of the field; however the new location that Mr Hicks has shown me is very slightly higher than the road-side location so could be construed as being more favourable if drainage were ever an issue. In my experience I would suggest that neither location would have any drainage problems.

Thirdly, we are waiting to receive final clarification on which site the Parish Council wish us to build it as well as confirmation as to whether wet pour safety surfacing be used or Safergrass mats. We posted the revised plan of the new location to Mr Hicks and Mrs Kilfeather a few weeks ago, but have had no subsequent confirmation.

I have again rung them both today but have had to leave messages. Until this is cleared up we cannot even start manufacturing the equipment. Once we have this confirmation we will need approx' 6 - 8 weeks before we can start the work and I anticipate that we will be on site for at least 2 weeks.

I hope this clarifies the situation and look forward to a speedy resolution.
